APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Motion was made by Commissioner Bradley to accept the minutes of the March 16, 2006 meeting, seconded by Commissioner Collins. All in favor 3 yes, 0 no. MOTION CARRIED.

Hart Jr. also discussed with Tom Pohl from OGS the issue of lease agreements that have not been signed in the past and that lease bills would not be sent out until these are received. Attorney Hart let Mr. Pohl know that the District would volunteer to get these lease agreements signed. Mr. Pohl is to get back to Attorney Hart regarding this matter.
